Dr. Sunao Ishihara received his PhD in precision engineering in 1992 for his work on synchrotron x-ray lithography from the University of Tokyo. He started work with NTT Electrical Communication Laboratories in 1973. After joining NTT, he worked and conducted micro- and nano-structure fabrication technologies including x-ray lithography. In 1999, he was appointed to the Director-General of NTT Basic Research Laboratories and directed nano science research covering the area from quantum information to nanotechnology. He has been serving on several committees of government and industrial associations to promote nanotechnology R&D for future industries. He has just started teaching and research in the Dept. of Engineering Synthesis, University of Tokyo, in 2005.
